
PLAN REVIEW

This plan may be amended by agreement of the parties as required. The plan is an operational guide for managing fish and wildlife in the TTC traditional territory over the next four years, but it does not limit management actions that the parties believe are necessary to address new concerns from time to time.

Two reviews of the progress on the action items in this plan will take place. In the spring of 2003, the first will be a mid-term review of the plan among the parties to determine progress on implementing the action items and recommendations, and to refocus the plan, if necessary. The second review will occur in the 2004-05 fiscal year, according to the following action items.

Develop a community questionnaire on fish and wildlife

This questionnaire is proposed as a precursor to the revision of the entire integrated plan the following year. It would cover everything to do with fish and wildlife and would function both as an assessment of community knowledge and concerns and as a valuable reference for the information and update phase of the plan revision. Host a community discussion on fish and wildlife information based on the plan. In preparing for the plan revision, the community would be presented with all the information acquired from the preceding three years of the plan, including scientific, local and traditional information.
