1. Meeting Start

The meeting started at 1:00pm on Monday, June 11th, 2012.

As there was no quorum, no decisions were made in this meeting as two members were unable to attend.

2. Updates

- Tess met with Janet Vandermeer in Whitehorse on April 1st, 2012 to learn about what the WRFN Traditional Land Use Study contains and how the study was completed.

3. Communications Discussion

- There is a need to discuss, with the whole steering committee, the December, 2011 open house in Whitehorse, and how to address communication issues so people feel like they are part of the planning process.
- It would be beneficial to meet with WRFN Chief and Council.
- The Dan Keyi RRC needs more information about the process; many members are unaware of what has been happening so far. It would be

beneficial to meet with them and provide them with regular updates of the planning process.

4. Discuss recommendations

Due to two members not be able to attend no changes to the draft recommendations were discussed. There was a discussion about what the steering committee has heard so far in the planning process as both the YG members were new and wanted to get up to date.

- Tess handed out draft recommendations on fish and wildlife for the committee to look at for structure.
- Recommendation highlights should ideally be ready for the KFN general assembly for community members to review (July 28th and 29th).
- Kym's direction from KFN is that they want hunting restrictions in the HPA. YG would want to discuss reciprocal provisions.

5. Next steps

- **Action item 1** – Kym will find out if the RRC is meeting over the summer and who the members are.
- **Action item 2** – Tess and Nathan will organize a meeting with WRFN Chief and Council to discuss to update them on the planning process.
- **Action item 3** – Tess will continue work on recommendations and send them out to members for review.

Tess will organize the next steering committee meeting for the beginning of July or after July 13th, 2012.
